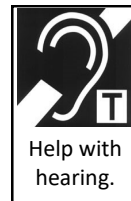

We raised over £1167.75 with the soup and sweet and baking stalls with gift aid of £79.50 and £559.20 for the rag bags. This was the most bags we have ever had. Weighed and shifted 1398 kilos 292 bags. The total raised was £1806.45

Thanks too to David Youngson and his apprentice Cameron for taking all the boxes up to the lorry assisted by Rosie's husband Alistair and Cameron Stephen and to all who have given goods and donations for the causes we support.

This year they are - 482 Christmas shoeboxes to Blythswood Care, blankets and hats to Aberdeen Neo Natal Unit and Peterhead Maternity. Trauma teddies to Children 1st. Used spectacles, hundreds of beanie hats, jumpers and children's clothes to Africa through The York St Fellowship's twice yearly shipment. Children's clothes, taken to Africa by Stewart Duncan, Louise's son. Men's ties sent through Sandy Garvock of Apex to the Philippines, as the women who live beside the dumps unpick them and make clothes with them.

We resume again in January when we will start all over again. We wait on God to guide us to those who need help and look forward to welcoming new friends to help us in His work !
